Required Lower and Upper Division Courses outside of the Department

The courses listed in this section can be taken concurrently during the first year of SPPA courses

- BIOL 1002 (1) Introduction to Biology Lab (Also allowed by catalog: BIOL 1004, 1005)
- BIOL 2010 (5) Human Physiology & Anatomy (Also allowed by catalog: BIOL 2011)
- PSYC 1000 (5) General Psychology (Also allowed by catalog: PSYC 1001, 1005, 2004, 2009)
- STAT 1000 (5) Elements of Probability and Statistics

While not required for the major, the following course is a required pre-requisite for SPPA 4854 and should be completed by the end of the Spring Quarter of your first year.
